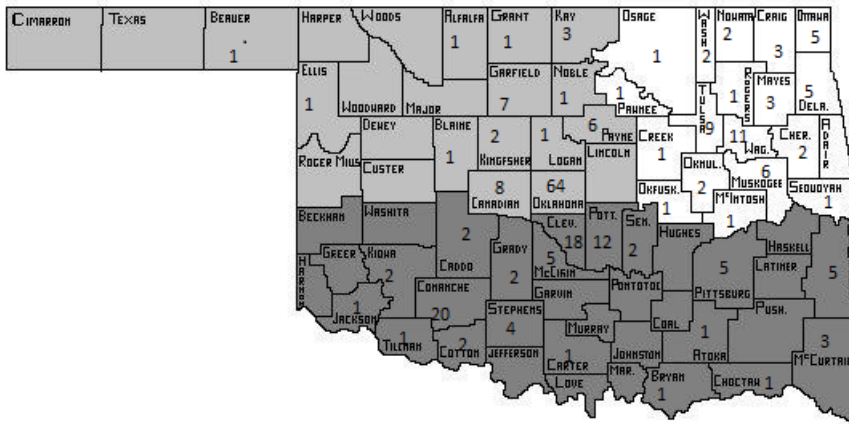


**OASIS / OKLAHOMA RESPITE RESOURCE NETWORK
 RESPITE VOUCHER PROGRAM
 Activity Report for July 1, 2011 – Sept 30, 2011
 FY 2012**

During this three-month period OASIS received 242 requests for new applications for both children and seniors, 572 requests for reapplications, and 363 calls regarding status of pending applications or reapplications. Eighty Five (85) of the contacts were for voucher applications for seniors handled through other agencies. These calls are referred on to those agencies. **

Requests for new voucher applications are represented below.
